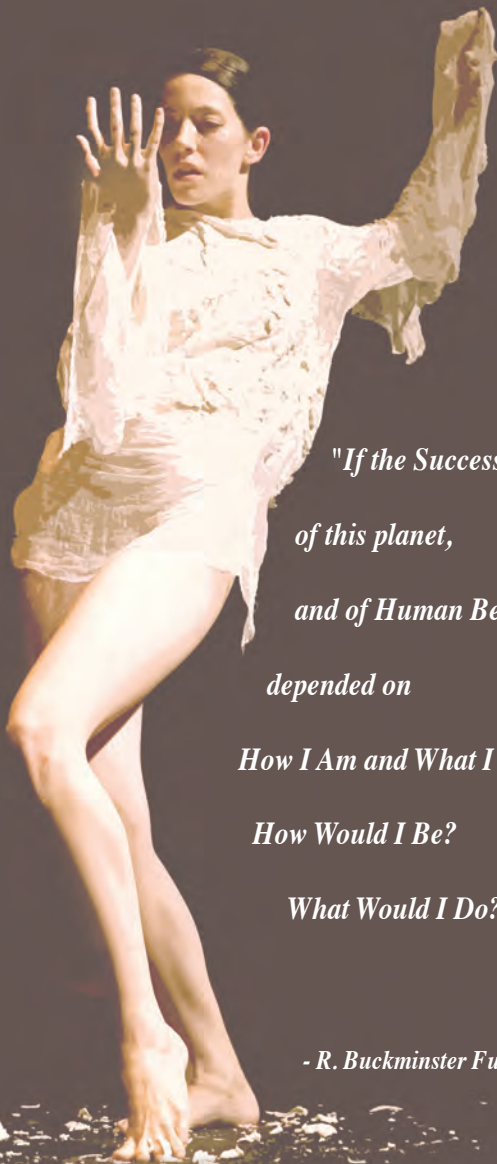
VERTIGO DANCE COMPANY

VERTIGO INTERNATIONAL DANCE PROGRAM

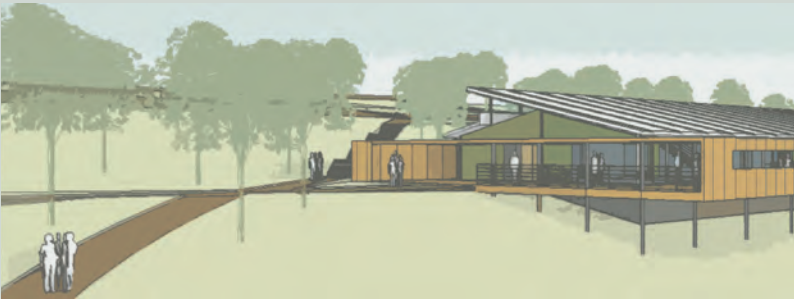
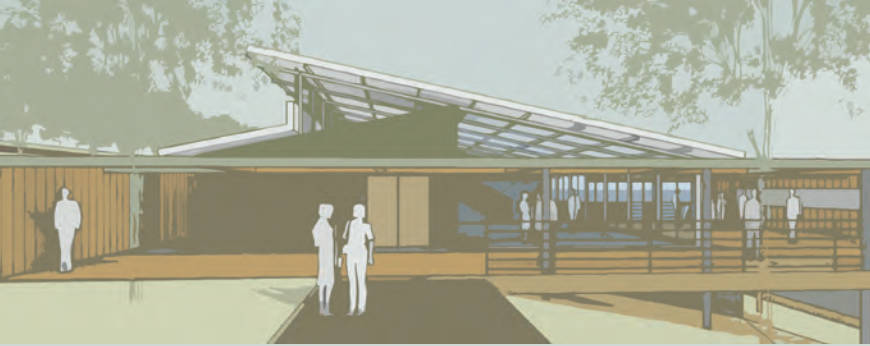

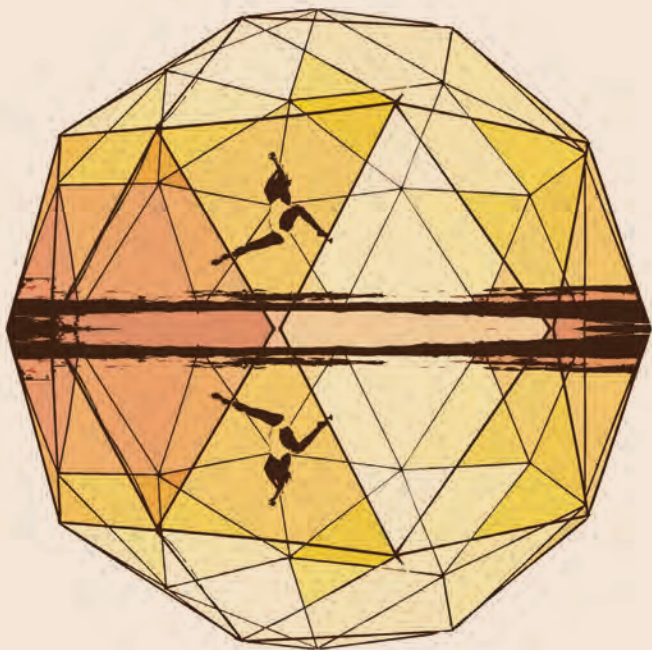
